Report of the 2007-2008 District 3 Lieutenant Governor – Lazar “Larry” ODZAK

At the first meeting of the District 3 Lodge, newly elected at the 2007 District Convention in Falls Church, VA., each Lodge Officer agreed to visit and administer a number of Chapters. In addition to duties usually assigned to the Lieutenant Governor, I visited and cared for the North Carolina chapters in Charlotte, Greensboro, Durham, and Raleigh. In due course, I also contacted, corresponded, and called on other NC chapters in Asheville, Wilmington, and Fayetteville. I visited all chapters except Asheville and Fayetteville.

At the end of June 2007, a couple of weeks after last year’s District Convention, I participated as a lecturer in our new program organized by Lodge member Aris Chronis – the AHEPA Academy. I gave a talk on Greek immigrants to the southern States, followed by a good discussion. In September 2007, I attended and participated in the District Leadership Meeting and Workshop organized by District Treasurer Steve Mavronis and very nicely hosted by his chapter in that fair city of Baltimore, MD.

In October, I initiated and participated in organizing a District Leadership Meeting and Workshop, hosted by our Gen. Nathaniel Greene chapter 257 in Greensboro, NC. Thirty-two [32] members from all but two of the above named NC chapters attended this very successful one day event, led by our District Governor Pete Chambers and also attended by all Lodge Officers.

Another duty usually performed by the Lieutenant Governor is to update, maintain, and publicize the District by-laws. With additional help by DG Pete Chambers, our by-laws are up to date and available at the District 3 web-site, so ably administered by our web masters Luke Hajjantoni and Jim Constantinides.
